MENTAL HEALTH

The Governing Board realizes that mental illness can seriously interfere with the learning process. Recognition of early signs of impaired mental health can lead to more timely diagnosis and treatment, which can benefit both the student and the schools.

The Superintendent shall maintain regulations and procedures which may result in early reporting of symptoms of impaired mental health and lead to timely diagnosis and treatment, as required and intended by law.
