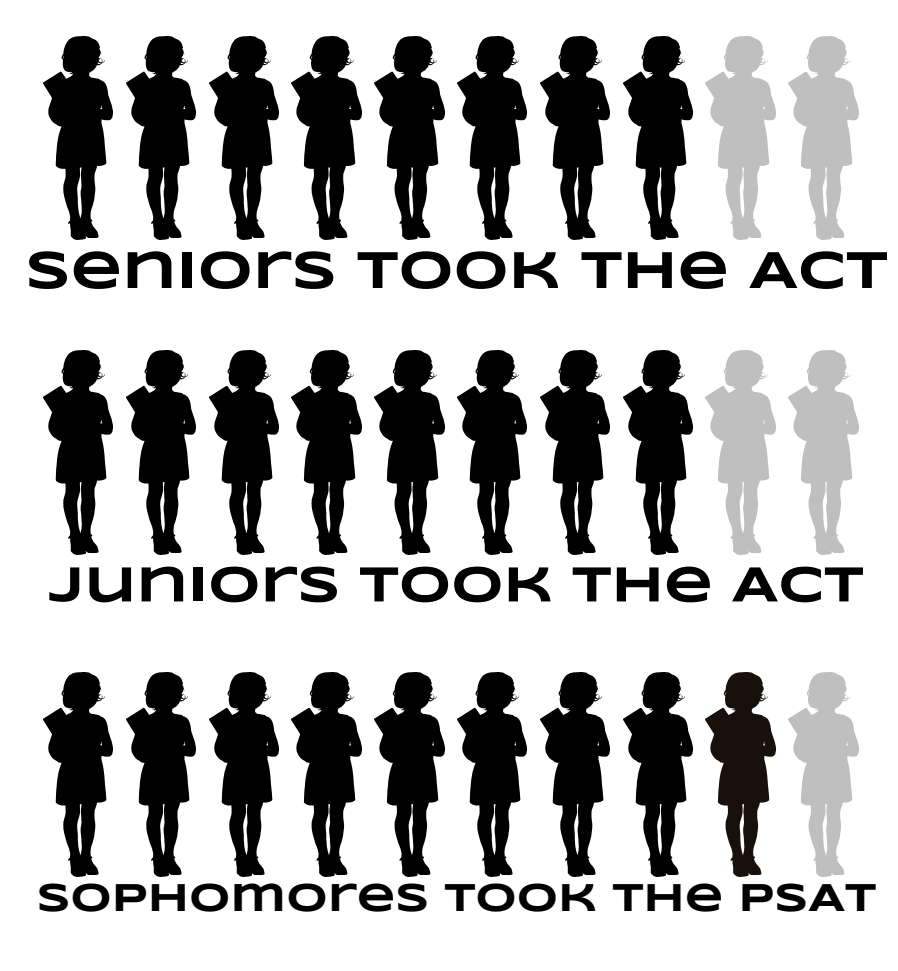

begins long before high school

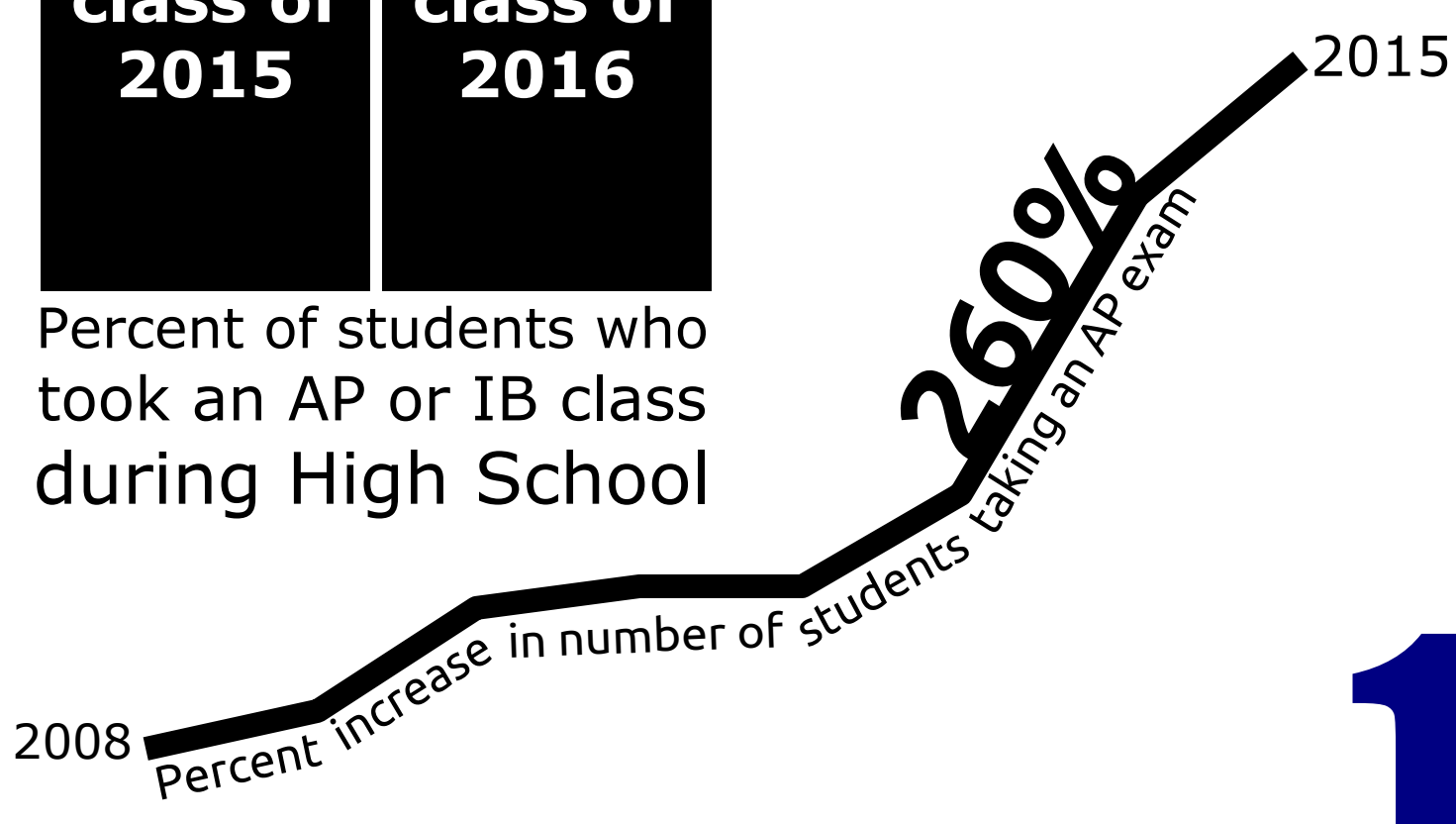
