Bathroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Give people privacy. ● Knock on the stall door if you are not sure if someone is using it. ● Make a line and wait your turn. ● Use your quiet, indoor voices. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Walk. ● Keep water and soap in the sink, trash in the trash can. ● Keeps lights on and main door open. ● Keep your feet on the floor. ● Go, Flush, Wash, Dry, Dispose. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Seek an adult if you see a problem in the bathroom.
Bus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Follow rules of the bus driver. ● Quietly get on and off the bus. ● Say “Thank you” when getting off the bus. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Remember to bring your belongings when you get off the bus. ● Bottoms to bottom of seat, back to back of seat. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Choose to sit next to someone who will not bother you. ● Discuss problems that happen on the bus with the bus driver.

Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Follow adult directions. ● Use quiet, indoor voices during lunch, speaking only to the people across from you and beside you. ● Say “please” and “thank you” when asking for something. ● Raise your hand to get up. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Clean your area. ● Eat only the food from your lunch. ● Eat it or leave it. ● Walk to and from the cafeteria. ● Remain seated. ● Cafeteria food stays in the cafeteria. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Choose to sit next to someone who will not bother you.
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Say “goodbye” to your teacher when you leave. ● Use quiet voices during dismissal as other students are still learning. ● Follow adult directions. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use crosswalks when crossing the street. ● Promptly leave the school grounds at dismissal. ● If you parent picks you up, stay in the parent pick up area, and watch for your parent. ● If you ride the bus, stay in the bus area. ● Primary students must wait for older siblings and/or parents at the parent pick up area. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Know where to go after school. ● Choose to be in a supervised area. ● Wait patiently in the office for parent pick up when necessary. ● Tell parent that you will be waiting in the designated and supervised area.
Dress Code	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Clothing should be clean, neat, and properly fitted. ● Clothing and jewelry should not be disruptive to the learning environment or to other students. ● Follow adult directions if you are asked to phone home for a change of clothing. ● To respect others’ health refrain from using or bringing perfume, aftershave, cologne, or perfumed lotions. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Choose clothing that does not bag, sag, or drag on the ground. ● Choose shoes that will be safe for the playground and for P.E. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Seek a wise person if you have questions about the dress code. Ask questions before you wear an item to school that you are unsure about.
Emergency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Give space to the person with the emergency. ● Share information accurately. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If someone needs help, tell the nearest adult quickly. ● Follow adult directions at all times during the emergency. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Know what to do in an emergency and where to go.
Guest Teacher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Treat the guest teacher like your regular teacher. ● Speak to the guest teacher as if the principal were listening. ● Follow the instructions of your guest teacher, even if they are different from your regular teacher. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Be flexible and helpful. ● Follow your personal standards at all time. 	

Hallways and Quiet Zones	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Voices off. • Yield to others. • Hold recess equipment quietly with both hands. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep an arm's length spacing with the person in front of you. • Walk at all times and stay in a straight line. • Keep clear of the red zone near doors. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose to be in line next to someone who will not bother you.
Health Assistant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use quiet voices. • Wait quietly until office staff can talk with you. • Say "please" and "thank you" when asking for something. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have an office or nurse pass before entering the office. 	
Media Center	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return books on time. • Use your quiet voice. • Follow directions from the Librarian. • Treat books and materials with care. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sit quietly. • Put books back where they belong 	
Playground	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow adult directions. • Play games by the rules. • Use kind words. • Be a friend; invite kids to play with you. • Be a good sport. • Leave rocks, bark, sticks, and nature alone. • Hold recess equipment quietly with both hands. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Freeze at bell, walk at whistle. • Use the bathroom and get a drink before the bell rings. • Put recess equipment where it belongs. • Snacks should be eaten at picnic tables. • Put trash in the garbage. • Stay inside the red line unless you have a signed pass from an adult in charge on the playground. • Stay on the school side of the first backstop. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the rules for games and equipment before you start playing. • Talk with your friends about following the rules. • Walk away from others who are bothering you. • Seek a wise person when needed. • Use paper, scissor, rock to solve a dispute in the game.
