As we approach the conclusion of your child's middle school experience, I want to pass along some important information that pertains to promotion and the transition to NP<sup>3</sup> High. This letter is to inform you of promotion eligibility requirements.

In order to participate in and be eligible for promotion to NP<sup>3</sup> High, students are expected to demonstrate a specific level of proficiency in their learning and citizenship. Students may not have any incompletes (I) or have more than one below basic score (1) on summative assessments for any standard, in any class. Additionally, students must demonstrate good citizenship.

Most of the eighth grade class have spent their entire middle school years with us and understand the importance of task completion and showing what they know. It is essential for students to complete all assigned work and re-assessments as needed by Friday, May 17<sup>th</sup>; this is a schoolwide expectation. To this end, the eighth grade teachers will do their utmost to be available to students and communicate concerns as they arise.
