Dear Parent/Guardian of a Student with a 504 plan at NP3,

We are reaching out to parents and guardians of students with 504 Accommodation Plans. As you have observed in the first few days of virtual learning, it is a much different experience when compared to learning within the classroom. Some of the accommodations in your student's plan will inherently be supported with the learning environment being at home (e.g. preferential seating/grouping, alternate setting for exams, and/or flexible seating/schedule). However, many accommodations (e.g. extended time on assignments and/or exams, text to speech, use of calculators, clarification of directions, and/or access to breaks) will be implemented and supported by your student's teacher(s). Please keep this in mind as your student engages in virtual learning opportunities and when he/she is completing assigned tasks/tests. Last, any direct service, such as social emotional support, will be provided virtually. Your child's service provider will reach out to you with details.

Please contact your child's 504 Coordinator (see below) with any questions or concerns. We know that this is a difficult time as we face unprecedented challenges and things are shifting rapidly. Know that we are here, albeit remotely, to support the continued academic success of your student. Please also know that the District remains committed to assisting your student in accessing the learning opportunities being provided to all students.
