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- Regular AP exams will be: **\$94** per exam, or \$40 per exam for students with free or reduced lunch.
- AP Seminar and AP Research exams will be: **\$142** per exam, or \$40 per exam for student with free or reduced lunch.

All students enrolled in an AP course at the start of the 2019-2020 school year will be automatically registered for the AP exam.

AP Spanish Language and Culture

All fees must be paid in cash. Students will receive a receipt for each payment made. Deposits are nonrefundable.
