

NP³ Schools Will Be Closed Tomorrow, March 13, 2020

Dear NP³ Families:

March 12, 2020

Good evening NP³ families. As mentioned in our previous communication, schools are dealing with a rapidly evolving situation. This evening we learned of an NP³ elementary student, who exhibited some symptoms and was tested for COVID-19. While we do not have a confirmed positive at our school and will not know the test results for a few days, we are going to take preventative measures to ensure the health of all of our students and **will be closing all of our schools tomorrow, March 13th**. MAP will also be closed tomorrow. This decision was made in consultation with Sacramento County Public Health.

While we know that this will cause an inconvenience for many of our families, please know that we have made this decision with the health and safety of our students and staff in mind. The elementary school is going through a deep cleaning this evening.

NP³ will now begin our two-week Spring Break on Friday, March 13th. During the break, all three NP³ schools will continue their deep cleaning of all campuses. With the information we currently have, we anticipate reopening MAP as scheduled on Monday, March 16th. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and will reach out during the break with additional updates when necessary.

NP³ students should plan to return to school on Monday, March 30th. High School students will take their remaining midterms when they return from Spring Break.

Thank you for your patience as we work to respond as quickly as possible to a rapidly evolving issue with the best information we have from expert agencies.
