There are many benefits to being bilingual and biliterate. Students who are proficient in at least two languages :

- perform better academically
- have better problem solving and pattern recognition skills
- are eligible for grants and scholarships that monolingual students are not
- on average, earn more than their monolingual counterparts with the same degrees in the same positions

THE STATE SEAL OF BILITERACY IS

an award given to graduating high school seniors who have studied and attained proficiency in English and at least one other language.

It is an acknowledgement by the State of California as well as certification by NUSD that a student is academically proficient in two or more languages.
