Welcome back for another week of virtual learning at NP3! Last week flew by, and we're excitedly anticipating this week's schedule with the continued opportunity to connect with our students! As we move in to this week, we will continue to spend time reviewing expectations and practicing online norms. - 1) In ELA this week, students will continue on with Unit 5, week 2. This week, they will focus on the essential question, "How can we reuse what we already have?" and the big idea of "What are ways people can take action?" They'll study realistic fiction, while focusing on summarizing to show understanding and identifying point of view. They will also review their knowledge of vocabulary to practice understanding homographs and learn about subject and object pronouns in grammar. Finally, in a few weeks, they will begin writing an imaginative narrative, which will culminate in an opportunity to share during the last week of instruction!
- 2) In Mathematics this week, students will continue on with Module 7, which focuses heavily on understanding quadrilaterals and their attributes, perimeter, complex area, and multi-step word problems. They will be back to the regular routine of Zearn + problem set each day this week!
- 3) **Find Your Voice: Habit 8!** Throughout April, our Leader in Me focus is Find Your Voice! This has to do with using knowledge of the 7 Habits to share learning, help others, and pursue passions and goals. This is a GREAT habit to practice while at home. There are SO many new ways to find your voice during this quarantine, and we look forward to hearing about how that's happening!
