IB Pathway at Inderkum

Students intending to pursue an IB Diploma or multiple Certificates should apply to be in Scholars classes during grades 9 & 10. While all underclassmen benefit from being part of IB MYP, Scholars classes are accelerated and more in-depth so students will be ready for the rigors of the IB DP.

The table shows the courses a student must take in order to be an IB

Diploma candidate as well as meet the requirements for graduation and university admission.

They would choose 3 Higher Level classes and 3 Standard Level classes. Additionally, they must complete the Core requirements of TOK, EE and CAS.

Students may take fewer DP classes during grades 11 & 12, in which case they will be eligible for DP Course Certificates. Their remaining courses would be AP and/or college prep, and they are not required to do the IB Core requirements, though they may opt to do so.

All DP classes last two years. Grades for Internal Assessments are reported to the IBO, and students take IB exams during May of the second year. Results are released in July.
