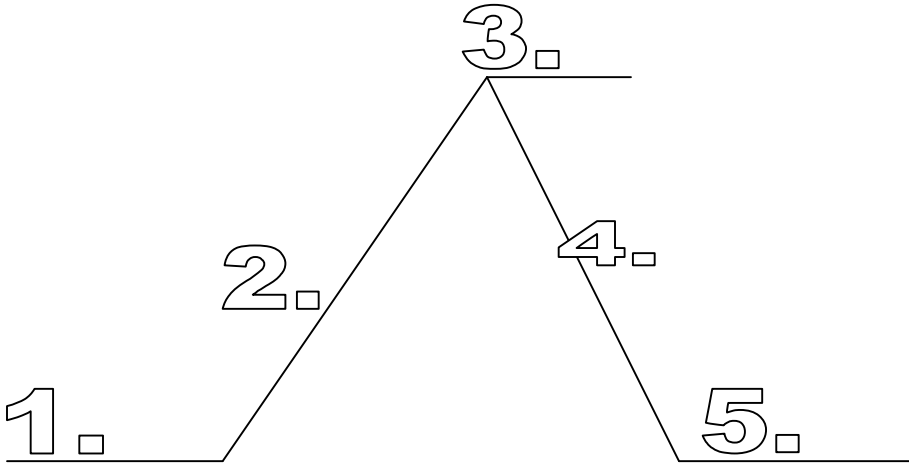


## Plot Diagram
