V.a. Approve the Educator Effectiveness Block Grant Plan

Recommended Motion: The Board is asked to approve the NP3 Educator Effectiveness Block Grant Plan for NP³ High, NP³ Middle and NP³ Elementary.

Rationale: The State Board of Education Educator Effectiveness Block Grant of 2021 awarded \$281,320 in funds to NP3 schools and allocated the funds in the following amounts: NP³ High \$113,422, NP³ Middle \$88,781 and NP³ Elementary \$79,117. The Board is asked to approve the spending plan that was recommended by staff and presented to the board in a previous board meeting. The recommended plan ensures funds will only be used to provide professional learning for teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals who work with pupils, and classified development of teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals, and classified staff.
