The 2022-2023 NUSD **Intra**district Open Enrollment Transfer request opens on November 1, 2021 and it is recommended that you submit your <u>request</u> early. This request is for families that live in Natomas Unified but want to attend a different school than their boundary school.

An **Inter**district Transfer Permit is required for students who live outside of Natomas Unified School District and want to <u>request</u> to attend a district school.
