Quick Summary / Abstract

Recommended Motion

The Board is asked to approve the 2021-222 Bond Performance Audit for Measure L.

Rationale

Proposition 39 stipulates the rules and requirements for a 55% General Obligation Bond. One of the requirements is an Annual Performance Audit consisting of an independent financial audit and an independent performance audit. The Performance Audit for Measure L will be presented to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee at the January 23, 2023 meeting. Independent Auditors, Eide Bailly, tested bond expenditures, fiscal reports, and fiscal procedures. These tests indicated that the Natomas Unified School District expended Measure L General Obligation Bond funds for the year ended June 30, 2022 only for the specific projects developed by the District's Board of Trustees and approved by the voters. The reports indicate that the District's bond expenditures, fiscal processes, and Citizen's Bond Oversight Committees are in accordance with the requirements of Proposition 39, as specified by Section 1(b)(3)(C) of Article XIIIA of the California Constitution. The Measure L Performance Audit is attached.
