In summary: In 22/23 there was an overall 2% participation increase in female athletes, to 31%, and male athletes remained the same at 33%.

Bannon Creek had the largest % increase for MS/K-8's with a total of 59% participation of all girls (a 23% increase from 21/22) and 48% participation of all boys (a 15% increase from 22/23).

Witter Ranch had the largest % increase for Elementary with a total of 48% for girls (a 17% increase) and 43% for boys (a 11% increase).
